The ICWMT11 will be held at **Beijing**, **China** on **October 21-24**, **2016**. The theme of ICWMT11 is "Green *Low-carbon *Circular *Development". Specialized experts and government officials will be invited to give keynote speeches on the pressing issues of solid waste; this will in turn provide the opportunity to share and exchange ideas among participants. All the English accepted papers will be formally published by ELSEVIER and submitted for EI (Engineering Index) and CPCI (ISTP) index. The Chinese Papers will be compiled into the Chinese processing but will not be published. The outstanding papers will be awarded and recommended to SCI journal after peer review.

Poster Time & Oral Presentation
